



EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (out of catchment) Senior Secondary Enrolment – Years 10 to 12

Balmoral State High School recognises as its primary responsibility, the provision of access to appropriate educational services for students whose principal place of residence lies within the school's catchment area. To achieve a balance between capacity and growth, Balmoral State High School may be unable to meet this obligation in the future, unless action is taken to manage enrolments. The Principal must restrict enrolment of out-of-catchment students to ensure in-catchment students can enrol at their local state school, without the requirement of additional facilities. Applications will be considered only where vacancies arise.

Upon receipt of your Expression of Interest your student will be placed on our Out-of-Catchment Expression of Interest list. Students and parents will then be invited to attend an interview. If a place becomes available for your student you will be contacted.

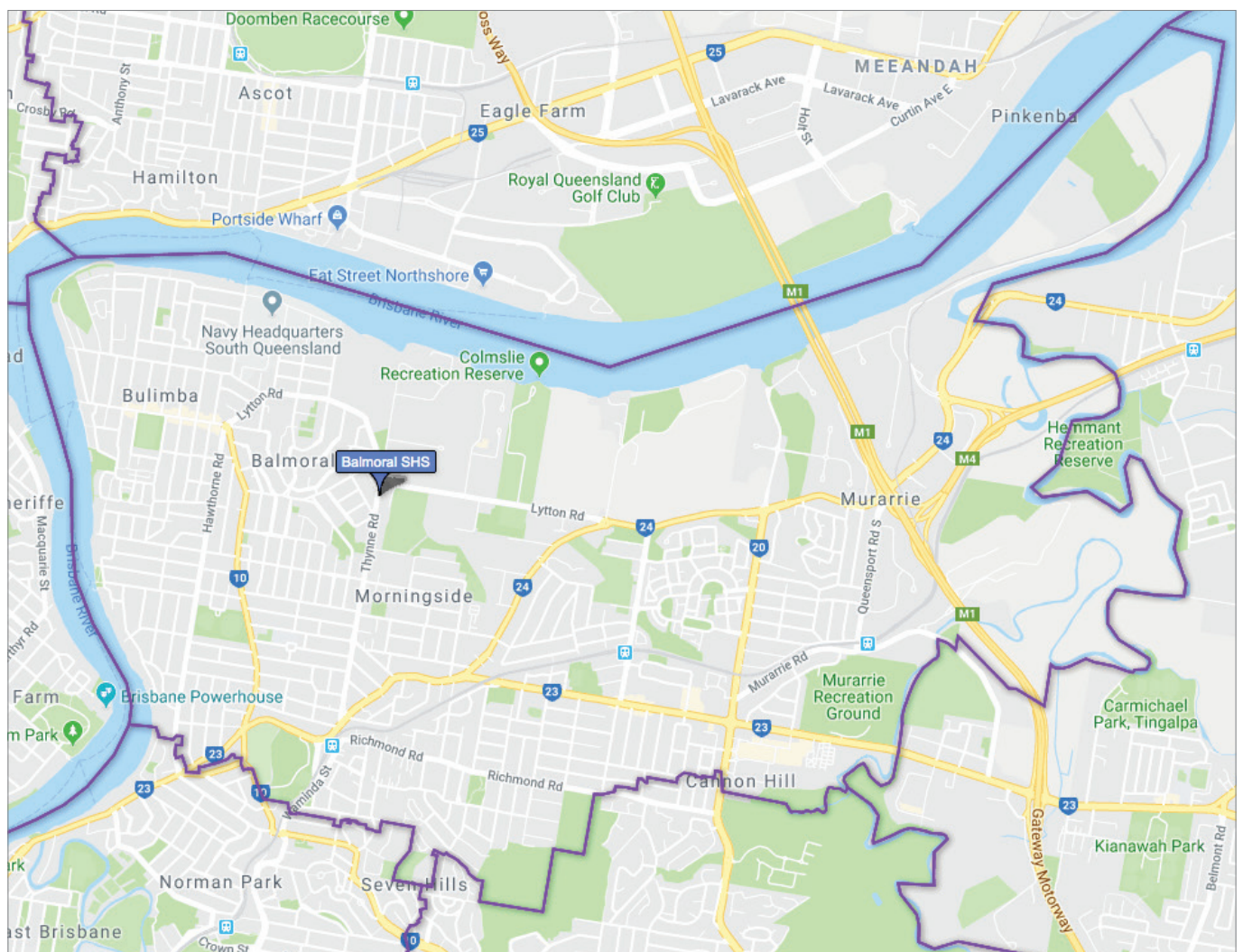
