

2026 Stationery Requirements & BYOD Specificaitons

(Bring Your Own Device)

General Stationery Requirements

These stationery items are ADDITIONAL personal subject items required and are not part of the Student Resource Scheme (SRS Scheme).

Excursions held throughout the year may incur additional fees.

All students are to provide the following: School bucket hat/cap (available for purchase from the school uniform shop), water bottle, school bag (clearly identified) and sunscreen.

For HPE and Sport - it is mandatory that students wear the Balmoral sports uniform, school bucket hat, sunscreen and water bottle.

Students will be issued a school diary and mobile phone pouch on Day 1 or Day 2 of the Induction phase for 2025.

Stationery required for Day 1-4x A4 exercise books and general writing implements & highlighters.

All students commencing at Balmoral State High School will be guided through the process on how to access the school network during the first few days of induction.

Laptops Year 7 are not required Day 1. Students will be told during the induction period (week 1) when laptops are required to be bought to school.

BYOD Bring your own device

PLEASE NOTE: The Following are <u>not supported</u>: Chromebooks, Android, Galaxy Tablets Windows 8.1 or older, Linux, iOS 12.x and older. Devices with snapdragon chips are also not supported. In 2025 we will no longer support Apple Devices. Windows 10 is end of life October 14, 2025 and therefore any device running Windows 10 after this date will also be unsupported

The Australian Government has introduced new laws, that mean you cannot purchase add-on insurance products such as ADP (Accidental Damage Protection) at point of sale, you will now be offered to purchase ADP via email 4 Days after purchase. We still recommend purchasing ADP.

Selecting a device for school

Device Requirements

The best way to purchase a laptop is to shop around your local retailers and take advantage of sales.

To make sure your device is suitable for the school please ask your retailer the following questions:

Can it connect to the school network?

Devices must be compatible with a 5Ghz Wi-Fi Network, often called "Dual Band Wi-Fi"

We recommend **Windows** devices over Apple devices at our school.

Never buy a Chromebook as they are not compatible with our school network.

If in doubt, ask your retailer "Does this device run Windows 11 and will this device connect to five Gigahertz Wi-Fi?".

Will it last the whole school day?

Battery life can vary depending on usage and batteries degrade over time.

We recommend an advertised battery life of 8 hours.

If in doubt, ask your retailer "Will this device last an entire school day, even after three years of use?".

Is it fast enough to be useful?

Our experience shows the two main indicators of BYOD performance is the number of CPU threads and SSD storage.

Never buy a device with a Mechanical HDD, always choose a device with at least a **256GB Solid State Drive (SSD)**.

Always buy a device with 4 or more CPU threads. in doubt, ask your retailer "Is the storage drive a 128 Gigabyte or larger solid-state drive and does this device have four or more CPU threads?".

If it Breaks, can it be Fixed?

Technology fails and accidents happen. Choose a device with more repair options to:

- Save money by repairing instead of replacing;
- Reduce stress when accidents occur.

We recommend choosing a 3 year Warranty and \$0 excess Accidental Damage Protection (ADP) with your device.

Or, choose a device which can be repaired by your local repair shop if it breaks If in doubt, ask your retailer "What repair options do I have for this device if it breaks?".

Required Software

You **don't** need to purchase any optional software (e.g. Microsoft Office) with your device.

We **don't** recommend purchasing Trend Micro or McAfee or any other anti-virus programs as they are often unsupported by the schools network and will stop your students connection to the schools network.

Please Note: that all windows devices come standard with **Windows Defender** and this is supported by the Department and the Schools network
